STATEMENT

Produits Dentaires SA provides Safety Data Sheets for its substances and preparations exclusively, as requested by international regulations (see below for the definition of substances and preparations). No SDS is issued for the products of our portfolio that do not fall within one of these categories because - unlike chemicals - they have no potential for adverse effects to people or the environment, and because no regulation requires SDS for such products.

Substance: means a chemical element and its compounds in the natural state or obtained by any manufacturing process, including any additive necessary to preserve its stability and any impurity deriving from the process used, but excluding any solvent which may be separated without affecting the stability of the substance or changing its composition;
